Description of Sessions

Teaching with Canvas

Teaching with Canvas is designed to help attendees understand how to use Canvas as instructors. This session assists those new to teaching with Canvas or those who would like to review essential Canvas concepts.

Unique Aspects of Canvas

Unique Aspects of Canvas is designed for instructors who would like to use technology and pedagogy to create a dynamic student experience, regardless of modality. This session is designed for Canvas users who want to take the next step and create an intentionally designed and impactful learning experience.

Digital Accessibility

This workshop focuses on the importance of digital accessibility and its impact on student access, covering accessibility standards and assistive technologies to build foundational awareness. Participants will learn how to use Microsoft Word and PowerPoint's built-in accessibility checker, apply effective formatting strategies, and ensure their documents meet accessibility standards.

Introduction to Generative AI

This session introduces faculty to the basics of generative AI and its applications in teaching and learning. Participants will explore how tools such as Microsoft Copilot, Google Gemini, and Notebook LM function within Texas A&M University's secure environment. The session will also include collaborative brainstorming on how these tools can support course design, provide feedback, enhance student engagement, and aid in content creation.
